Overview

According to the plan set out by ARTIS – Art History Institute and approved by the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT), the development of azulejo studies remains one of the main axes for the strategic development and promotion of the institute, both nationally and internationally. However, 2020 was an extremely atypical year, due to the need to find efficient ways to cope with the unprecedented challenge of the Covid-19 pandemic, faced by society as a whole. On the one hand, the fact that we were unable to access the office of the Azulejo Research Network for several months led us to rethink the computer model underlying *Az Infinitum*, the project around which most of the group's activities are organized; on the other hand, the researchers managed to take advantage of these constraints, turning them into new opportunities.

As regards *Az Infinitum – Azulejo Referencing and Indexation System*, we initiated the migration of the data to a new web-access platform and launched a discussion about the new research and data visualization options, to be made available online in the system's 2.0 version. However, circumstances ended up prompting a much deeper restructuring than originally planned. The system was originally based on a local-access technological setup, that is, the data could only be uploaded using the computers located in the office of the Azulejo Research Network, at the School of Arts and Humanities of the University of Lisbon (FLUL). Due to the pandemic, and except for January and February, the access to the computers was either blocked or strongly discouraged for several months. Consequently, we had to rethink this model and started considering, during the lockdown period, the possibility of switching to an web-access structure. A decision was reached in October – made possible by the invaluable support of the company Sistemas do Futuro (SF), and in line with the previously agreed protocol – and the content updates were formally suspended. However, the computer-related obstacles put up by FLUL led to a halt in the operation. In December, SF offered to temporarily lodge the new system in one of its servers, allowing students and teachers to reaccess the system from any location, an option which would only fully materialize in 2021. It was also in October that the graphic and technical features of the new *Az Infinitum* interface began taking shape, after several meetings with a team from SF and external designers.

Despite all of these setbacks, the work related to the MA and PhD projects and dissertations continued. Rafaela Xavier completed her MA thesis, entitled *Cataloguing Hispano-Moresque Tiles in Portugal: The National Palace of Sintra as Case Study*, which was awarded 20 points, the highest classification (the student and researcher concluded her MA programme with 19 points). She also submitted an application to the FCT's Call for PhD Studentships and was the highest-ranking applicant in her panel, thereby securing the necessary conditions for the pursuit of her research project, focused on the cataloguing of Mudejar tiles and initiated in October. This has lent a new impulse to the project *Cataloguing Portuguese patterned tiles*, making up for the unsuccessful application to the *Call for scientific research and technological development projects in all scientific domains 2020*, equally promoted by the FCT.

Still on this topic, the cataloguing 18th-century tile frames continued, and *Az Infinitum* was also used, for the first time, to catalogue industrial tiles. To this end, the researcher Pedro Ferreiro was given a copy of the system with web access, which allowed him to catalogue the patterned tiles he planned to include in his thesis, and which belong to the *AIAI – Association for the Interpretation of Industrial Tiles*. Moreover, a specific handbook was created for the module "patterns and frames".

It was a strong year in terms of applications, with six proposals presented to national and international competitions. This growing demand attests to the group's prestige, increasingly sought as a host unit for different research projects. Three proposals were submitted to the *Call for scientific research and technological development projects in all scientific domains 2020*, of which one was led by the group's coordinator and two others involved the

Azulejo Research Network; two proposals were submitted by national and foreign researchers to the 3rd edition of the *Scientific Employment Stimulus – Individual Call*, also promoted by the FCT; a further proposal was submitted by the group's coordinator to the *ERC-2020-COG: Consolidator Grant* programme and succeeded in reaching the second stage of the competition. All of these proposals were related to *Az Infinitum*. Among them, however, only one of the FCT projects involving the Network was approved for funding: *ChromAz – The Chromatic Journey of the Portuguese Azulejo*, led by NOVA.ID:FCT (VICARTE).

Apart from the important role played by the cataloguing of patterns in these proposals, it is also worth highlighting Vera Mariz's application to the individual CEEC call (*Thinking outside the wall – The Collecting of Azulejos in Portugal*), which aimed to contribute to the development of tile provenance studies by establishing a direct link between *Az Infinitum* and *Orion*. The project was not approved for funding, but it enabled the realization of a series of tasks of great utility for the future of this research domain. Finally, still within this context, a special mention is also due to the internship *Erasmus+ Mobility for Traineeship (SMT)*, through which Marietta Chikhladze, from Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University, was to have uploaded a series of entries on the iconography of Queen Ketevan in tile decorations. Unfortunately, this was only partially achieved, due to the restrictions imposed by the Covid-19 pandemic.

The following partnerships were established with other entities: a protocol signed with the Monastery of Saint Vincent Outside the Walls on 30 March 2020; the preparation of a new proposal for the inventory, catalogue and study of a group of scattered tiles belonging to Lisbon's Holy House of Mercy (Santa Casa da Misericórdia); the collaboration in an exhibition on the history of the Viúva Lamego Factory (Abrunheira, Sintra), inaugurated on 31 January 2020, with the presence of His Excellency the President of the Republic; the participation in the jury of the prize *National Palace of Sintra: a contemporary outlook on Hispano-Moresque tiles*, awarded by Parques de Sintra.

The AzLab seminars, suspended between March and June, were resumed in a new, online format, and the cancelled sessions were replaced by the "AzLab ao minuto" series, a collection of short videos created to commemorate the launch of the group's YouTube channel. From October on, the AzLab sessions were held exclusively via Zoom, with the presence of renowned foreign researchers, in an effort to seize the opportunity for long-distance communication offered by the pandemic. The number of registrations, from all over the world, reached record levels, leading the AzLab far beyond the Portuguese borders.

The 1st Free Course on Azulejo Studies was prepared. It was scheduled to take place in the first semester of 2021, via Zoom. The registrations opened in December and were sold out in three days.

Lastly, it is important to mention the social impact of the scientific activities promoted by Az, along with its outreach activities (the regular management of its social networks – Facebook and Instagram – as well as attending to the most diverse requests by students, researchers, artists and the public). It is also worth highlighting the production of a promotional video about the Network and its activities, directed at a wider audience and made available on YouTube.

Following the previous partnership, the publisher Centro Atlântico still sponsorships AzLab offering books, notebooks, and bags to the participants and invited speakers.

Mosteiro de São Vicente de Fora

The cooperation protocol with the Monastery of São Vicente de Fora [Saint Vincent Outside the Walls] was mediated by its governing body, the Lisbon Patriarchate, and signed on 30 March 2020. It is primarily aimed at the cooperation in common activities and projects related to research in Art History, and particularly on *azulejos*; the joint organization of scientific and cultural outreach activities, such as conferences, colloquia, tours, book publications or even exhibitions that are in the interest of both parties; and the collaboration and mutual support in publicizing activities aimed at the preservation of tile heritage.

All activities undertaken in the context of this protocol will be mediated by specific agreements, which will establish the details of the cooperation. The first of these agreements focused on the inventory of the lower cloisters, in the context of the MA research project of Patrícia Rodrigues.

Objectives & Achievements

Summary

The **Az Infinitum** - **Azulejo Indexation and Referencing System** is an online platform permanently updated. It allows the recording of data regarding buildings, *azulejo* coverings, authorships, bibliographic and documental references, images, etc., organised according to five major areas: *In situ, Authors, Patterns, Iconography, Bibliography*.

The data results from specific research projects, as well as MA and PhD thesis or post-doctoral research.

Objectives

Az Infinitum - Azulejo Indexation and Referencing System was developed to be the anchor project of this research group, gathering the scientific research in different areas and chronologies. Sufficiently flexible to answer wide-reaching needs, the systematisation of knowledge that is proposed will, in a near future, enable a renewed perspective on the history of tiles in Portugal. Hence, the main objective of Az Infinitum is to be a reference to the study of Portuguese tilework.

This requires continuing the investment already made and providing the system with a growing volume of qualified data, extending partnerships and streamlining new research projects in the various areas available. At the same time, the possibility of opening up other areas of systematization is being studied, as it is the case of engravings as sources of inspiration for figurative painting, fundamental for understanding the cultural and pictorial universe of painters from different periods; the old photos; and the thesaurus.

2020 – Na exceptional year

Initially, the difficulties in accessing the office of the Azulejo Research Network, due to the pandemic caused the new coronavirus, *SARS*-CoV2, prevented the update of *Az Infinitum*. Later, they led to the suspension of the system's online version, as already mentioned in the summary. The work carried on in Excel files, created according to *Az Infinitum*'s data structure, but we choose not to quantify this work, as it did not have a direct impact on the database.
